Restorative practices are derived from the philosophy and principles of restorative justice which are inclusive decision-making, active accountability, repairing harm and restoring trust. Retributive systems and processes ask: Who's to blame? What punishment do they deserve? Restorative practices ask: Who's been harmed? What are their needs? And: Whose obligations is it to meet their needs? Restorative innovators are designing and implementing systems and processes which prevent harm from occurring in the first place, and to respond to conflicts when they do arise.

The conference is an opportunity for practitioners, scholars, First Nations leaders and other experts and knowledge holders to discuss current and emerging restorative practice across a range of domains. These include: justice, education, healthcare, workplace relations, First Nations communities, faith communities, environment, families, cities and domestic, family and sexual violence.

LOCATION: CANBERRA

Canberra is one of the world's great national capitals, and one of the few planned cities on earth. The Ngunnawal people are the traditional custodians with the name Canberra stemming from the Ngunnawal word Kamberra which means 'meeting place'. Canberra showcases the diverse history of our country and is home to the Australian Story. It is a city of over 450,000 people and is geographically nestled between the Snowy Mountains and Australia's high country and the pristine beaches of Australia's east coast.

Canberra is the home to the Federal Parliament of Australia which sat in Canberra for the first time in 1927. It is also home to many other important national institutions such as the judiciary, defence and intelligence agencies, the International diplomatic community, and world-ranking universities such as the Australian National University.

Canberra has more attractions than any other Australian capital city, with an array of world class museums, galleries and institutions housing some of the most valuable of Australia's artworks, war memorabilia, documents, publications, archives, music and sound recordings.

Many of the most significant attractions are located on either side of Lake Burley Griffin. These include Parliament House, the Museum of Australian Democracy, the National Library of Australia, the National Portrait Gallery, the High Court of Australia, the National Gallery of Australia, the Australian National Botanical Gardens, the National Museum of Australia and the National Archive of Australia.

The Canberra as a Restorative City vision is to grow the ACT as a safe and connected community where relationships are valued, problems are solved jointly, and every person is treated with respect, care and dignity. This makes Canberra a fitting location of the International Contemporary Restorative Practice Conference in 2024.

CONFERENCE PROGRAM

The Canberra conference will spotlight innovative practice across diverse practice areas, with a focus on:

- The lived experience of practitioners and participants in restorative processes
- Collaboration between restorative programs; and
- Engagement with related fields of practice.

It will also be a chance to share insights about common core skills for:

- Implementing programs (including managing culture change)
- Integrating related practices and initiatives; and
- Generating new knowledge.

This will be achieved through a combination of keynote and expert presentations, the presentation of case studies, as well as participatory methods such as Open Space Technology.
